



FAQ'S ABOUT MZBC CAMP

Parent FAQ's (Frequently Asked Questions)

- Who is primarily invited to your camp?
 - MZBC Camp is primarily set up to minister to Christian kids from solid, independent, Baptist churches. However, we do see a few campers saved each year.
- What kind of medical personnel do you have present at the camp facilities?
 - We have do have at least 2 medical staff on-call on site 24 hours a day
- What should I expect in the case of an emergency?
 - A medical staff member or the Camp Director will contact you.
- What should I do in the case of an emergency?
 - Contact your pastor first and he will give you directions as to what to do next.
- How many camp workers are at camp?
 - We strive to have at least a 1 worker to 5 camper ratio with 2 counselors in each cabin.
- What is the cost/camper for a week at camp?
 - \$110/1st camper in a family (with Early Registration Discount)
 - \$100/2nd camper in a family (with Early Registration Discount)
 - \$90/3rd camper in a family (with Early Registration Discount)
- What is the cost/worker for camp?
 - \$50/worker for the week (includes all meals and activities)
- Can I sponsor a child/teen to go to camp?
 - Yes. See your local church pastor about this opportunity.
- Can we come over and visit the camp?
 - Yes. We have camp parent night on Tuesday night from 7:00-9:00 pm. We invite all parents of campers to join us for this evening of fun and preaching

Camper FAQ's

- Is there an extra cost for any activities at camp?
 - Bring enough spending \$ for a Camp T-Shirt or hat, snacks, and spiritual resources (CD's, books, etc.).
- Can I bring medication, paintball or fishing equipment to camp?
 - Yes. However, it must be labeled clearly and turned in at registration.
- Who will be in my cabin?
 - Generally, campers that are the same age are placed in each cabin. We do try our best to accommodate requests, and we try to place at least one other person from your church in your cabin.
- Can I bring my cell phone?
 - No camper is allowed to have a cell phone at camp.
- What should I bring?
 - You will receive a thorough packing list of what to bring and what not to bring from your leader in your church before you come.
- What if I leave something at camp?
 - All lost and found will be kept 2 weeks after camp. A camper must call and pay for shipping of the item in order to get it back.
